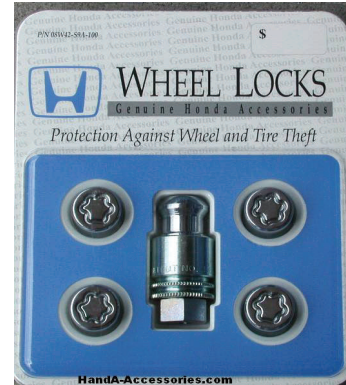


DO YOU KNOW WHAT THESE ARE?



**These are just some examples of a
“WHEEL KEY\LOCK”
*They don't all look like this!***

Most cars, especially higher end vehicles come equipped with a “wheel lock” or “wheel key” to lock the hub caps to prevent them from being stolen.

If your vehicle is equipped with a wheel key or lock, then please provide it each time you come in for service, as it is very difficult and time consuming to get your wheels off for service without it.

Also, you should know where your wheel key or lock is in case you have to remove the wheel when you have a flat tire. Common storage areas are the glove compartment or trunk with the spare tire.

If you are unsure as to whether your vehicle has a wheel key\lock, look in your owner's manual.

We will do all possible to remember to replace your wheel key or lock when we're finished with it, but as extra insurance, when you pick up your car please check to ensure it has in fact been put back.
